10:15 - 10:25	10"	Objective 2: Secretary's Report - Silvia  Review of Minutes from last meeting (see below and on website)  By-laws review  Website has been renewed for next year. Thank you for your donations!
10:25 - 10:55	30"	Best practices for centralizing transcript reviews (Nicola Williams) - Discussion led by Jeff Lash  Several districts discussed their experiences in creating a centralized location for international student registration and transcript evaluations.  What do other School Systems do at the end of the year. Especially HS, when students arrive at the end of the year, yet we need to enroll them. Do any school systems have a cut off date for new enrollments? Kindly advise.  Most districts continue to enroll, as students have the right and there aren't any policies indicating a cut-off date in state regulations. However, in VA policy says students who enter late should get alternate ways to get credit. This could be placing students into semester courses, enrolling in summer school, or placing in electives with the expectation that no credit will be earned for that term.  Has anyone in Virginia schools used the Good Cause waiver (VDOE) for international students that were seniors (graduate in year 11) in their home country but have relocated to your school district?  See chat for VDOE link For students who could have graduated in their country (after 11 years) but want to earn a US high school diploma by going

		to 12th grade - it is not automatic that they will be placed as seniors here. Must meet all graduation requirements including credits and exams. In Montgomery County MD, students who have graduated in home country get a graduation letter, referral to community college, and possibly referral to WES (World Education Services) to get their HS diplomas validated.  Can school districts who use Oral Declarations share details on their procedures? (Jill Tucker)  Some districts will do Oral Declarations only for refugees (checking I-94 for refugee status is permissible), and others can take other circumstances into consideration. Check website for additional comments and forms being used for Oral Declarations by MAFSA members.  Is there a written process that schools use to train counselors on SLIFE interviews, transcript evaluations and interviews? (Anna Maria Johnson)  Howard County shared their handbook, there is also the SLIFE guide put out by the VDOE, and sample interview questions on the MAFSA website.

11:25		<ul> <li>Norka (MCPS) talked about their district's creation of curriculum guides for Math, Science, and Social Studies, which have been developed in collaboration with their subject area specialists and can be used to identify specific courses instead of generic course title (i.e. Algebra 1 instead of Math, Biology instead of Natural Science, etc.). She will invite their Math content specialist to the next meeting to discuss how this resource is being developed. <u>Honduras</u>			Like many international countries, Honduras uses an integrated math curriculum. Instead of giving students credit for Algebra 1A/Geometry A for 9th grade math, the thinking is if students have all of these courses then this is the MCPS Aligned Course. The textbooks for Honduras do have some Geometry components as early as 7th grade. However, Geometry is really covered in Grades 8 and Grade 9

No Failing grades. Students with a C (Inicial) grade must receive a written report from teachers indicating how to improve. Students repeat a grade if they have a C grade in 4 or more subjects (out of 11 on curriculum). Marissa has a report card with both numeric and alphabetical grades which will be posted to the Country Profiles folder.
